1. Codorniu Pinot Noir Brut Cava

Full-flavored with a lasting finish. An exciting sparkling wine that livens up your mouth. **92**

2. Jaillance Crémant de Bordeaux Rosé

Very creamy and flavorful. An interesting sparkling blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Really good. **92**

3. Forest Glen Forest Fire White Merlot 2005

A sexy pink hue makes way for a complex, slightly sweet wine with a kick. A well-made wine that drinks well by itself and even better with some food, particularly Asian fare. **91**

4. Chateau Bonnet Bordeaux 2005

From the first sip, you know this one is a winner. Light and refreshing. Easy to drink many a glass. **91**



5. Jacob's Creek Sparkling Rosé

Proof that Australia's sparkling wines are some of the most under appreciated bubbly out there. This is quite yeasty and full flavors of raspberry. **90**

6. Louis Jadot Rosé 2006

Dry and mouth-filling. An inviting nose with floral aromas. A hint of spice on the finish. **90**

7. Wyndham Estate Bin 505 Shiraz Rosé 2006

When a country, on the whole, makes such good Shiraz, it should come as no surprise that a Shiraz Rosé is a winner. This one has a little spice, a little cherry, and it's just a well-made and exciting wine. **90**

8. Carmen Rosé 2005

Packed full of strawberry flavors, this blend of Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon has a pleasant acidic balance and a lasting finish. **89**

9. Scott Harvey Rosé of Pinot Noir 2006

Pretty dry and very complex. You can tell this Napa Valley wine is well-made by a very talented wine. **89**

10. Makulu Pinotage Rosé 2006

With distinct characteristics of a South African Pinotage but lighter, this Rosé displays different flavors that are soft and easy to enjoy. **89**

11. Sauvion Rosé d Anjou 2005

From France's Loire Valley, this wine displays a welcome touch of sweetness, which makes it very tasty. **88**

12. Hook & Ladder White Zinfandel

Ah, yes. There should always be at least a few White Zins in the mix when tasting Rosé. Flavorful and slightly complex. Better than you might expect from a White Zin. **88**

13. Luccio Rosé

Sweet and fun. Enough said. **88**

14. Stonewood Cellars White Zinfandel

Light and fairly fruity, this wine displays a mixture of flavors, especially. It's a good find and well worth trying. **88**

360 Applicious

4 oz. 360 Vodka
4 oz. DeKuyper Sour Apple Pucker Schnapps
2 slice
Granny Smith Apples

360 Breeze

2 oz 360 Vodka
4 oz. Grapefruit Juice
1 oz. Cranberry Juice

Pour 360 Vodka into iced highball glass and fill with grapefruit juice and top with cranberry juice. Garnish with a lime wedge.

360 Cashew

1 oz. 360 Vodka
1 1/4 oz. Fazkar Feni cashew apple liqueur
1 oz. Apple Juice
1/2 oz. Sweet and Sour Mix



Reyka Flame of Love Martini

3 oz. Reyka Vodka
1 oz. Dry Sack Sherry

Serve in a chilled Martini glass and garnish with a flamed orange twist.

Reyka Iceberry Martini

1 1/4 oz. Reyka Vodka
1/2 oz. Black Raspberry Liqueur
1 1/2 oz. Lychee Juice
1 Orange Wedge

Serve in a chilled Martini glass and with an orange wheel and a blackberry.
