Faiveley Bourgogne Blanc 2004

Clean and fresh with just the right amount of acidity. A Burgundy that's still affordable. Very good. **91**



Trinchero Family Syrah 2006

Aromas of blackberries lead to rich and balanced flavors of strawberries and a hint of chocolate. Well-rounded with a pleasant finish. Good by itself but even better with something off the grill. **89**



Kendall-Jackson Grand Reserve Merlot 2004

Intense all the way through - from the first sniff to the lingering finish. Full of rich fruits, especially cherry, this wine fills the mouth with delicate flavors and a slightly tannin finish. A must for Merlot lovers and Merlot critics alike. **89**



Crane Lake Pinot Grigio 2006

One of those affordable summer wines that doesn't disappoint. Nothing too complex but just a fun wine to chill and sip on a summer afternoon. At about \$5, a great value, too. **86**
